Outline Syllabus

Differences between leadership and management. Definition of leadership. Who is a leader? Introduction to a range of leadership theories and styles. Self-assessment of own leadership style and development needs. Approaches to personal and team motivation, motivation and job and role design Difference between groups and teams; Team formation team roles, high performance teams, multi-agency teams
Power and conflict; definitions and types of power and control. Conflict; causes, types, strategies to prevent and manage conflict. Introduction to managing change. Organisational culture.

Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

The module will be delivered using a blended approach of online and on-campus activities. Teaching will include key lectures, seminars, directed study, and tutorials, which will be delivered via the University's virtual learning environment and through group lectures and activities.

LO 1a is developed & achieved through series of research informed lectures that cover key topics that will be further explored in student-centred directed learning. Online activities will be used to explore subjects explored in lectures & provide students with opportunity to discuss & analyse topics (LO 1a, 2a-b, 3a-b). Learning outcomes 1a, 2a will also be addressed using directed study, this will enable students to develop & expand their knowledge by undertaking guided reading.

All LO are assessed via a written assignment. Students will be able to submit work prior to the final submission date & receive formative feedback.
