Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

Based on your approved dissertation proposal you will be allocated a suitable supervisor. You will undertake 8 hours of introductory workshopseminars in Semester 2. 2h seminars will be scheduled over 4 weeks and two of them will be face-to-face, in person discussion sessions and two will be scheduled, live, online discussion sessions.

A total of 20 hours supervision time is allocated, out of which three hours is intended to be used as one-to-one contact time with the supervisor. The additional time will for your supervisor to review your work and provide feedback. You will work largely on theiyour own, and you are expected to initiate and maintain regular contact with your supervisor. Your supervisor will give guidance on the agreed dissertation proposal, provide guidance on methodology and methods as well as to provide feedback on your work as you go through the module.
