Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy
Students will learn through placement experience, peer group supervision and individual tutorials. At the start of the placement, students will develop a Placement Learning Contract. Drawing on set criteria that relate to key transferable skills; graduate employability skills; and the Public Health Knowledge and Skills Framework, students will identify (with the placement mentor), specific learning and development needs and how these will be evidenced at the end of the placement experience. 2000 word reflective portfolio; 10 minute presentation; completion of placement experience (P/F)
