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| Tasks and responsibilities will vary according to the host placement organisation. There is no defined syllabus and placements are made available by voluntary cooperation of companies and other organisations. The activities and duties while on placement will depend to a large extent on the nature of the business/profession. Students must complete a minimum of 120 days in the workplace using a maximum of three placements. Students may complete a combination of placements both overseas and in the United Kingdom, including a semester of study abroad, provided these requirements are met. |

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| <p>Placement organisations will be responsible for designing a scheme of work and experiences for the student, giving initial training for the task(s) set and encouraging the student to work independently and take responsibility for the project(s) concerned.</p> <p>Assessment will be by the employer's report confirming that the student has completed the requisite time. The placement report (5000 words) will demonstrate the student's knowledge and understanding of the host organisation and the need for, and value of, the projects undertaken. It will also have a reflective element allowing the student to explore their own strengths and weaknesses and include a curriculum vitae demonstrating the experiences and skills acquired during the placement year.</p> |
