Module Aims
The module aims to enable students, working independently, to demonstrate the ability to plan and carry out a critical study of an identified problem area that integrates concepts, theories, knowledge and skills encountered on the programme.

Outline Syllabus
This is an independent piece of work with students working under the supervision of an allocated academic tutor. Students will be allocated an academic supervisor with whom they will meet regularly. Workshops will include guidance on: identifying an area of specialist focus; producing a proposal; literature searching.

01	Identify, plan and carry out an independent piece of work under appropriate supervision.
02	Demonstrate an ability to engage in and sustain independent, intensive study indicating sound knowledge of concepts and theories applicable to an identified area of specialist focus.
03	Make considered judgements about the appropriateness of research methodologies in relation to academic debates.
04	Critically analyse and evaluate relevant literature and research findings to generate debates within the specialist focus.
05	Engage critically with academic sources and present ideas and arguments in a well-structured and coherent manner.

Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy
Learning is mainly through independent study, supported by workshops, VLE materials and academic supervision. Students will produce a proposal for their study (LO 1, 4, 5) to test its soundness and to identify appropriate academic supervision. Under supervision the student will produce a study of an area of specialist focus (LO 1, 2, 3, 4, 5). The module is assessed by a 1000 word proposal and a 3000 word study of an area of specialist focus.
