Module Aims
The module provides you with an opportunity to apply the knowledge, understanding, and skills gained throughout the programme in a professional setting. In this sense, this module will help you to gain practical experience in the organisational environment and assess career opportunities. Furthermore, it aims to enable you to reflect critically on your own work practice in preparation for and during your placement, and to develop initiative, autonomy, and team work skills, among other skills.

Outline Syllabus
There is no defined syllabus and placements will be sourced either by UoB or student (via the university's careers centre). Students will be placed with a remuneration at the ?living wage? level, either through UoB funding (direct financial contribution) or employer funding (if available). The placement activity must be agreed by the Programme Leader. The activities and duties whilst on placement will depend to a large extent on the particular nature of the business/profession. Irrespective of the nature of placement work, it is a normal expectation that students on placement would develop and demonstrate communication skills through reports and orally to supervisors and senior managers, and do so independently and as part of a team, and to tight deadlines.

Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

The duration of the placement is 12 weeks. The placement work is directed by the supervisor appointed by the provider, but the student will be appointed an academic tutor who will remain in contact to check that integration into the workplace is proceeding and that the work being required of the student is appropriate and at a later stage to assist and advise both the student and the employer as to the requirements of the assessment process.

The student's performance during the placement (including the fortnight diary, reflective end of placement report, and placement supervisor assessment) will be assessed on a pass/fail basis.
