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| <p>Study abroad years are voluntary and additional to the 360 credits you study towards your degree at Bradford. Modules selected will be relevant to your University of Bradford degree and agreed with the Programme Leader. The range and variety of teaching and learning methods will depend on what is offered by the host partner institution. During your year abroad a tutor from the University of Bradford will remain in contact with you.</p> <p>In addition to your study and assessment at the partner institution, you will keep a reflective log or journal of your learning and cultural experiences. In July following completion of your study abroad you will submit a Portfolio which should be no more than 5000 words. The Portfolio must contain the transcript provided by the host institution, your CV incorporating information on the skills you acquired while abroad and the reflective log/journal of 1500 words for assessment. The reflective element will convey your experiences and learning as well as any problems encountered and how you overcame them. Assessment will be on pass/fail basis.</p> |
